DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN CHONGQING

Welcome to Chongqing! Upon arrival, meet your driver and transfer to the hotel for check-in and rest. Take the evening to explore the city at your own pace, try the famous Chongqing hotpot, or relax after your journey.

DAY 2: PANDAS & CITY HIGHLIGHTS

Start your day with a visit to Chongqing Zoo - Panda Pavilion, where you can see adorable giant pandas, including rare twin cubs born in 2021. Next, stroll through the historic E'ling Park, a former private garden perched atop a hill with stunning panoramic views and a romantic history tied to Chiang Kai-shek and Soong Mei-ling. After lunch, immerse yourself in the charm of Shancheng Lane, a hidden gem featuring boutique hotels, traditional eateries, and creative bookstores. Continue to Jiefangbei Pedestrian Street, the city's bustling commercial hub, before heading to Hongya Cave, an iconic riverside stilted building complex where you can experience the city's vibrant nightlife, street food, and breathtaking views of the Yangtze River.

DAY 3: WULONG'S THREE NATURAL BRIDGES

After breakfast, take a scenic 2.5-hour drive to Wulong's Fairy Mountain Town. Upon arrival, transfer to an eco-friendly shuttle to visit the breathtaking Three Natural Bridges, a UNESCO-listed karst wonder and the only outdoor filming site of Curse of the Golden Flower. Located 3 km from Fairy Mountain, this 5A-rated scenic spot features three massive stone arch bridges—Tianlong, Qinglong, and Heilong—rising above deep canyons. Shaped by nature over millions of years, the bridges showcase a stunning mix of grandeur and mystery. Enjoy a 2.5-hour exploration before settling into your mountain lodge for a peaceful evening.

DAY 4: FAIRY MOUNTAIN

After breakfast, drive to Fairy Mountain and ride a small train to the grassland core. After lunch, return to Chongqing and visit Danzishi Old Street, a historic 4A-rated scenic area blending old-town charm with modern city views. End the day at Liziba Light Rail Station, where a train passes through a residential building, an engineering marvel unique to Chongqing.

Voluntary Changes:

Please note that any changes or upgrades requested after the booking is confirmed will be subject to a fee of AUD220 per person per change, in addition to any applicable supplier costs. This fee covers modifications to flights, hotels, tour dates, or any other services included in your package. To ensure smooth processing, we kindly request that you provide us with a minimum of 72 hours notice for all voluntary changes.

Cancellations & Refunds:

Please note that in the event of tour cancellation, a cancellation fee of AUD550 per person will be charged, in addition to any relevant supplier costs. Refund requests must be submitted in writing and will take up to 6 weeks to process. It is important to note that no refunds can be issued once the tour has commenced (for the flight-inclusive package, no refunds can be issued once the flights have been ticketed).

Name Correction Fees:

A fee of AUD220 per person applies to name corrections on documents, along with any supplier costs. Kindly note that name corrections must be requested at least 72 hours prior to departure and are subject to approval from the supplier.

Document Change Fees:

A fee of AUD220 per person will be charged for any passport changes, in addition to any applicable supplier costs. Please note that train tickets and admission access must be linked to your travel passport details. Any changes to passport information must be requested at least 14 days before departure and are subject to approval from the supplier.

Supplier Fees:

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

TRAVEL INSURANCE
